Any other omnibus course can be approved if it meets the relevant criteria and is submitted according to regular procedure. The following conditions will apply.

- a. The application will be for a specific course identified by title.*
- b. The application must include documentation of the unit's intent to apply for a regular course number after the course has been offered twice.*
- c. Approval will be for one semester.*
- d. The course can be renewed for up to two additional semesters by certification that any changes have not affected fulfillment of General Studies criteria. After the*

course is approved for a regular number, it will be resubmitted to the GSC in order to be granted a GS designation(s).
